

Electing County Assembly Officers

When you start your assembly, you will want to vote in officers when you feel the group is ready for them.

Once you elect a moderator/President/Chairman or whatever you choose to call that position, the County Organizer's position will end. You may want a Bailiff or Sgt at Arms at some time.

Next you will need either a Secretary or Scribe.

The problem of being a scribe is you are so busy you cannot take part in the meeting.

A scribe writes down most of what is said, such as:

John said the Xmas party should be on Sunday.

Mary said why **go, there will be no booze there or Chip N Dales cause it's on Sunday.**

Tom mad the motion to have the party at a strip club.

Horney Harry seconded that motion.

A Secretary records only the bare facts and decisions made.

From Secretary:

1. **Present:** Tom, Mary Jack and Jill.

1) Xmas party Discussed.

Resolved: Party is Saturday night at Bills House.

Byob.

2) Fact Finding excursion on the Chip N Dales was discussed.

To be discussed furher at next meeting.

3) Next Scheduled meeting is March 15th, 7 PM.

Note Until the officers are elected, the County Organizer will act as Moderator and Secretary. Once those positions are filled, the County no longer needs an Organizer, unless the Assembly decides otherwise.
